THAT the authorization for a lump sum contribution of \$50,000 to the districts Texas County District Retirement System (TCDRS) account for plan year 2023 is hereby approved.

Chief Appraiser, Marcel Pierel reported to the board that the bats were removed from the building. The parking lot flooded with the heavy rain last week and some employees got water in their vehicles. With all the construction, it took longer for the parking lot to drain off. Also, appraisers are beginning field work and Preston Brown took new appraisers on a field training day. In addition, Mr. Pierel reported there is not an update on the Property Value Study yet, but we received the 2022-2023 Preliminary MAPS Review, and we received a score of 100 in all categories. Mr. Pierel also gave the directors a summary of how SB 2 directors terms will be affected.

The Board adjourned into Executive Session at 10:20 a.m. and reconvened into open session at 10:53 a.m.


